Chamblee called the meeting to order at 2:05 pm in Coskrey Auditorium in Memorial Hall. Henington moved, seconded by Ebanks, to approve the minutes form the April 20, 2007 meeting. Wolverton and Edwards-Henry pointed out corrections that were needed. The motion passed unanimously.

Palmer moved, seconded by Wolverton, to approve the Graduate Policy for AOCE. The motion passed unanimously.

Palmer moved, seconded by Henington, to approve the AOCE offering of IE 7000 Directed Individual Study, IE 8000 Thesis Research/Thesis, and IE 9000 Dissertation Research/Dissertation. The motion passed unanimously.

Palmer moved, seconded by Henington, to approve the modification and AOCE offering of the Geospatial and Remote Sensing Technology Certificate. It was noted that only the Geosciences courses had been approved for AOCE. Chamblee stated that the original proposal would be edited to indicate the courses that had not been approved to be offered through AOCE. The motion passed unanimously.

Palmer moved, seconded by Henington, to remove from the table the Master of Science in Industrial Engineering and the Doctor of Philosophy in Engineering-Industrial Engineering concentration and approve the AOCE offering of the two degrees. The motion passed unanimously.
