The Meridian campus only serves upperclassmen, so there are no freshmen or sophomores currently in the major.

What are your plans for accommodating students in the program? By rule, students must be accommodated with "minimal disruption". This means students cannot simply be expected to switch campuses-they must be accommodated. For instance, Meridian students may continue to attend courses in person in Meridian, but the course will be synchronously taught by a professor in Starkville.

Selected College of Business core classes will be offered in Meridian in support of the BS in Healthcare Administration major. The College of Business offers asynchronous online business courses through the Starkville campus and Online Education campus. Meridian students will be permitted to enroll in these sections if a course is not offered at Meridian but needed to graduate with the BBA.

How will students be advised during the Phase Out?

Candy Adams is their current advisor. She will continue to advise them until graduation.

Students and Faculty must be informed of the plans PRIOR to closure. How will this be accomplished?

Faculty have already been informed about the closure by Dr. Terry Dale Cruise, Associate Vice President and Head of Campus, and Dr. Harold Jones, Interim Associate Vice Provost for Health Sciences.

Students have already been informed by their academic advisor.

How will you redeploy faculty and staff in this program?

Faculty and staff have been redeployed in the BS in Healthcare Administration major.
