1. Program Proposals by college/school:

Due to the changes to the Math Gen Ed (Change Notice 2, 2022-2023, effective Fall 2023), which renamed Mathematics and Statistics to Quantitative Reasoning, reduced it from 6-9 hours to 3 hours, and removed MA 1313 College Algebra from the Gen Ed, programs were asked by the Director of Academic Quality to submit forms designating how the degree program would handle the reduction of 3 hours. Options included:

- "No Action-Degree Program already requires math courses beyond College Algebra, so no change (i.e., Math Education requires 12 math courses beginning with Cal 1) or College Algebra is important to the degree"
- "3 hours-free electives"
- "3 hours-to select from CO 1003 Fundamentals of Public Speaking or CO 1013 Intro to Communication"
- "3-hours-removed from degree program"
- "We will be submitting a full program modification to be effective Fall 2023"

General Science

Modification to General Education Math Requirement

The General Science degree program currently requires 6 hours in math: 3 hours of MA 1313 College Algebra or MA 1103 College Algebra Corequisite Model or MA 1213 Math in Your World plus 3 hours of a higher math.

With the Fall 2023 changes to the university's General Education requirements, the decision has been made to modify the General Science degree in the following ways:

- Reduce the math requirement to 3 hours on A&S core, which will be modified to remove MA 1313
 College Algebra, MA 1103 College Algebra Corequisite Model, and MA 1213 Math in Your
 World
- Reduce the total hours required for the General Science degree from 124 to 121

The decision to reduce the math and total hours requirement was based on the following:

- The total enrollment in General Science over the last two years is 10 students.
- Of those 10 students, only 1 entered the major at the time of admission to MSU.
- Of those 10 students, 9 completed the entire math requirement before entering the major.
- Of those 10 students, 5 were eligible to immediately enter a higher math course.
- Of the 5 students who did <u>not</u> have the ACT-M score to immediately enter a higher math course, 4 completed at least <u>two</u> higher-level math courses beyond College Algebra before they became a General Science major. Courses taken were Trigonometry, Statistics, Calculus I, Business Calculus I, and Calculus II. (Students who bypassed College Algebra had also taken these courses as well as Foundations of Math and Statistical Inference.)

Given all of the above, reducing the math requirement and total hours requirement for General Science students is the best course of action. For students who have the necessary ACT-M score to immediately enter a higher math, reducing the total hours for the degree is the most logical, efficient choice. Students who need to take College Algebra as a prerequisite for a higher math will still be able to count it toward their free elective hours.
